- Describe and discuss in detail the port and shore side facilities which you would expect to see at a deep sea iron ore loading terminal and their importance to the operation.
- 2. Discuss in detail the ship to shore interface you would expect to take place to ensure the safety of VLCC berthing and sailing operations at an offshore terminal.
- **3.** You are the Operations Manager for a container terminal. Discuss the differing types of containers which you would expect to handle in your port, and how a terminal would be equipped for this.
- **4.** Explain in detail what techniques ports are employing to ensure the effective control of bad debt during an economic crisis.
- **5.** You are the manager of a busy general cargo port, and berth efficiency is critical to your operation. Discuss the port performance indicators available to assist you in your role.
- 6. Discuss any five of the following:
 - a) Stowage Factor
 - b) Angle of Repose
 - c) UNCLOS
 - d) Trust Port
 - e) LASH Vessel
 - f) Midas Port
 - g) Free Trade Zone

- **7.** Discuss and describe the various health and safety practices you would expect to see in a container port/terminal.
- **8.** You are the General Manager for a port with a mixed range of general and container cargoes. You believe the potential exists to build a new transit shed in the port. Prepare a detailed proposal to your board highlighting the opportunities that you believe could be realised by this project.
